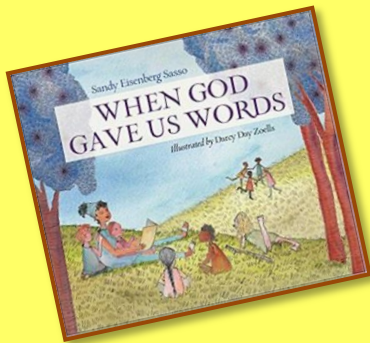

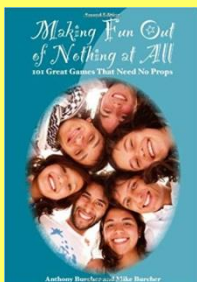


When God Gave Us Words by Sandy Eisenberg Sasso, Illustrated by Darcy Day Zoells (FlyAway Books 2018)

This children's book tells a story of what it may have been like when God gave humans words even though the angels didn't like the idea. Beautiful art depicts the world as humans learned to use the words.

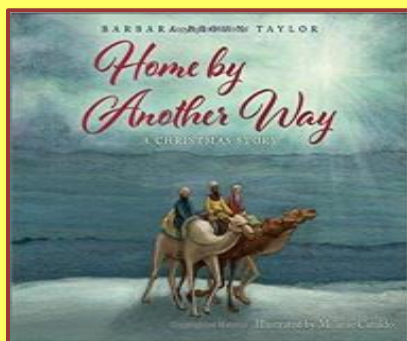
101 Games that Teach Storytelling by Anthony Burcher and Mike Burcher (Healthy Learning 2013)
