Hope this newsletter finds you and yours healthy and doing well and that you were able to enjoy a little better holiday time together this year than last year.

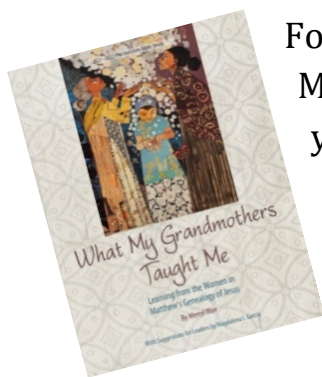
