
1. To know the content of the Bible,

3. To be aware of God's self-disclosure, especially God's redeeming love as revealed in Jesus Christ, that they may respond in faith and love..."

This latest offering is titled **Responding to God's Grace** and includes a Leader's Guide, a Participant Book and Worship Leaflets. The Worship Leaflets are to be used as very short worship with the actual study done in the middle of worship. The leaflets often include a familiar hymn that may be sung if the class chooses.

The Leader's Guide includes a main idea, the background scripture and a verse for the class to remember, as well as main teaching points and a detailed-yet-short lesson plan for teachers.

The Participant's Book gives participants the verse to remember and a short one- or two-page reading. Each reading is followed by a question for discussion.

If your class wants to do an old-fashioned yet very relevant Bible study, then **THE PRESENT WORD** may be a suitable choice. It is good solid scripture studies, which the lesson makes relatable to our lives today.
