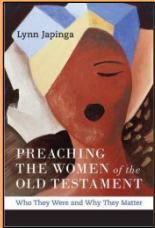


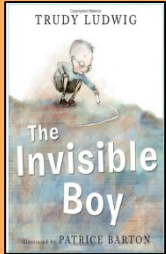


Introducing New Resources From Your Resource Center

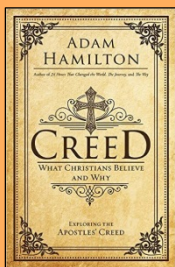
***The Invisible Boy*, Trudy Ludwig; illustrated by Patrice Barton, (Knopf)**

Have you ever felt invisible, or do you know children who seem invisible? Brian is treated like he is invisible. The other students in his class don't see him because he isn't loud or good in sports. His teacher doesn't seem to see him because he doesn't cause problems in class. Brian isn't chosen for games or invited to parties. All this changes when a new boy comes to school. Brian's kindness helps others see him as his invisibility dissolves.
