#### Course Description:

Having something to say is one thing. Crafting how to say it is entirely something else. This workshop will help participants consider the roles of language, imagery, and stories in preaching, where to find them, and how to (and how not to!) use them in preaching.

**Richard Voelz** is an Assistant Professor of Preaching and Worship at Union Presbyterian Seminary in Richmond, VA. Formerly, the Senior Minister of the Johns Creek Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in metro Atlanta, Richard has over a decade of ministry experience in various contexts. He has written several books, including *Tending the Tree of Life: Preaching and Worship through Reproductive Loss and Adoption* and *Youthful Preaching: Strengthening the Relationship between Youth, Adults and Preaching*; and has contributed to other books on preaching and worship. Rich previously taught a course on preaching in our Authorized Lay Preacher/Commissioned Ruling Elder preparation program.
