Information for those considering a workshop application:

Once again, we are pleased and excited to bring an inspirational day of keynote and workshops to the people of the Presbytery of West Virginia at the Festival of Faith 2020, to be held on Saturday, March 28.

As with years past, we will offer several workshop times – three slots for one-hour workshops or a two-hour time slot (which will coincide with two of the one-hour slots). Workshop proposals may be for one hour or two hours in length. You may also want to consider two or three one-hour workshops that, while connected, could also be standalone programs on related topics.

We hope to offer workshops that mix church “how to” classes with workshops that are entertaining and joyful for Presbyterians. The Planning Team encourages you to think about church professionals as well as the “people in the pews.” In order to prepare and distribute packets, we must have all workshop information turned in by **Thursday, November 14, 2019**. At the Planning Team meeting following that date, those who have submitted workshop applications will be notified as to whether or not they have been selected.

Please keep in mind that all expenses associated with a workshop leader must be covered by the committee or person sponsoring it (resources and supplies, transportation, housing, and meals, including lunch.) The Festival of Faith team will provide free event registration for up to two leaders per workshop; additional leaders must pay at the time of registration. If you are selected to lead a worship, please be sure to complete and return a registration form; these will be available in late January. **We need all leaders to be registered.**

Jill Duffield will give the keynote address and will offer a workshop. Duffield, a Benedictine columnist for the *Outlook* since 2010, is the first woman to serve as editor at *Presbyterian Outlook* in the publication’s 157-year history. She has been in the position since 2014. She graduated as a member of Phi Beta Kappa from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro with a Bachelor of Arts in history. Her graduate studies include a Master of Divinity degree from Union Presbyterian Seminary in Richmond, a doctorate in ministry from Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary with a concentration in preaching, and studies in medieval church history at the University of Pennsylvania. As a teaching elder, Duffield has served both large and small congregations in North and South Carolina. She has preached at Montreat Conference Center in North Carolina and served as a commissioner to the 219th General Assembly.
