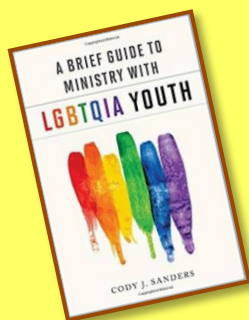

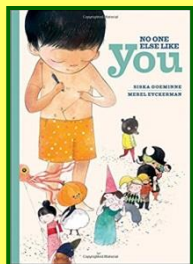
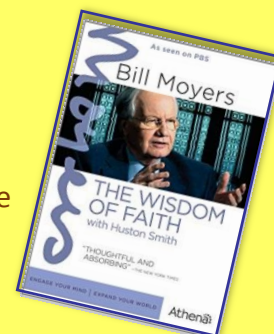


A Brief Guide to Ministry with LGBTQIA Youth, by Cody J. Sanders (Westminster John Knox Press [WJK])

This small book was designed for congregations with an affirming stance toward the LGBTQIA community. It offers practical advice and useful tools to help church leaders and members be prepared for tough questions and a better understanding of the issues LGBTQIA youth face today.

Houston Smith claims all religions, at their core, are the same. These two DVDs include a series of conversations with Bill Moyers, as Smith “provides his insights into the world’s largest religions and how, taken at their best, they provide universal truths that unite and define the human spirit.” The total time is 276 minutes.

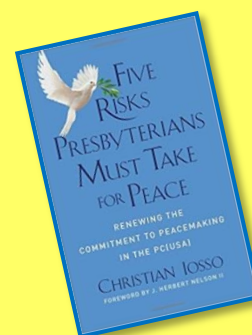


No One Else Like You by Siska Goeminne, Illustrated by Merel Eyckerman (WJK)

Five Risks Presbyterians Must Take for Peace: Renewing the Commitment to Peacemaking in the PC(USA) by Christian Iosso (WJK)

Written in response to our denomination’s Peacemaking Policy approved by the General Assembly in 2016, Iosso has included the five affirmations interpreted in the book as five “risks.” He explains how they differ from previous peacemaking positions and examines previous peacemaking statements, including the idea of just wars. Included at the end of each Risk chapter are questions for study and reflection.
