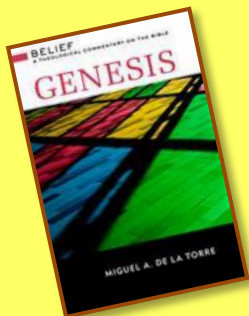
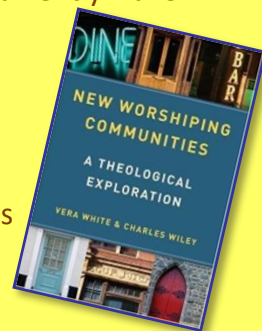

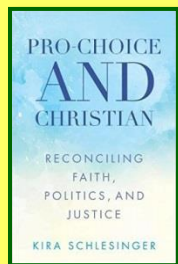
Belief, A Theological Commentary on the Bible (Westminster John Knox Press [WJK])

New Worshiping Communities: A Theological Exploration by Vera White & Charles Wiley. WJK

White and Wiley provide and discuss theological and Biblical foundations to the 1001 New Worshiping Communities movement in PC(USA). The authors explain what is meant by “New,” what is meant by “Worshiping,” and what is meant by “Community.”



Pro-Choice and Christian: Reconciling Faith, Politics, and Justice by Kira Schlesinger (WJK)

Explores the Biblical, theological, political and medical aspects of the abortion debate in order to provide a thoughtful Christian argument for a pro-choice position. The author discusses relevant scripture as well as the political and social justice issues. She also provides common vocabulary for discussing faith and reproductive right.



No Innocent Bystanders: Becoming an Ally in the Struggle for Justice by

Hannon Craigo-Snell & Christopher J. Doucot (WJK)

This book looks at the role of allies in social justice movements and asks what works, what doesn't and why. It is good for spiritual or religious people who are interested in social justice but don't know where to begin. The book may be used as a group study with six “lessons,” including the introduction. Each chapter is followed by discussion questions. Participants should be ready to read the chapters before class.
