All leaders – ministers of Word and Sacrament; Certified Christian Educators; Certified Associate Christian Educators; Commissioned Pastors; candidates, inquirers, and supply preachers including Authorized Lay Preachers; officers and employees of the Presbytery; members of committees, councils and commissions – are required to complete a Healthy Boundary Training Workshop. The Book of Order requires that training be completed every 36 months.

The Committee on Ministry and the Vocations Committee are tasked with implementing this updated requirement. There are three more opportunities for leaders to receive the required training led by Susan Sharp Campbell and Maureen Wright. There is no cost and lunch will be provided.
