
NOBODY CRIES WHEN WE DIE: God, Community, and Surviving to Adulthood

THREE SIMPLE QUESTIONS TO HELP CHILDREN KNOW GOD

A SIX-WEEK STUDY FOR CHILDREN BY DAPHNA FLEGAL

Want a short-term class for children? This course could be used for Sunday school, summer Sunday school or a middle of the week class. As I read through the study, I think it could fairly easily be developed into a multi-generational class. The six lessons include:

Question 1 Who is God?

Weeks one & two: 1- God is Love; 2-Jesus Teaches us about God

Question 2 Who Am I?

Weeks three & four: 3-Made in God’s Image; 4-Beloved Child of God

Question 3 Who Are We Together 5-The Family of God; 6-Followers of Jesus
