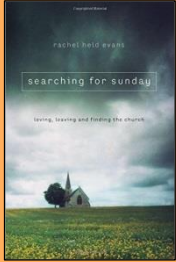


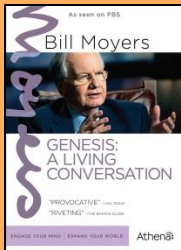

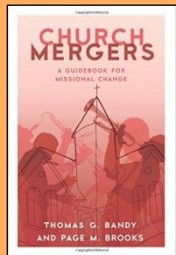
Searching for Sunday: Loving, Leaving, and Finding the Church, Rachel Held Evans, (Nelson Books)

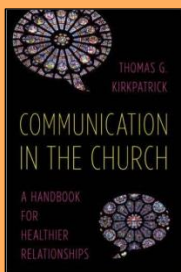
Genesis: A Living Conversation, Bill Moyers, (PBS, Athena) DVD set
