Bible Study for Women

Are you looking for something new this fall? How about offering a bible study for women in your congregation or as a community ecumenical study class? **Sisters: Knowing God, Making God the Main Thing in My Life** by Kimberly Dunnam Reisman may be just what you are looking for. **Sisters** is a series of Bible studies for women by Reisman, with **Knowing God** as the first of the series.

In this study, Reisman leads participants on a six-week exploration of their relationship with God, asking “Who is this God we believe in?” “How has our relationship with God unfolded in our lives?” and “Who are we in relationship to God?”

The study includes a DVD, Leader’s Guide and Participant’s Workbook with very short daily readings and questions to ponder. At the end of each week, the class meets to watch a short video then continues with a group discussion, going over the week’s readings.

The study leads to easy discussion and is best for small groups of 15 or less; it would even work for two or three participants. The Leader’s Guide gives very specific help and works well for someone with little group discussion leadership experience.
