My mother, who passed when I was but a child, bequeathed her love of Judaism to me, imploring my father in her last days to provide a Jewish education for her three sons. It is to her that I have dedicated my volunteer efforts. My father taught me to support and love my family and left me an appreciation for music and humor. I have passed these gifts to my children in his honor.

There have been other gifts; mentors who led me on a path of community service. Gifts from Jewish Hartford from its earliest days to now. To the leaders who came before us I say thank you for what you built and left for us — the wonderful synagogues and agencies and schools we all enjoy. There have been gifts of education, cultural arts and healthy living. 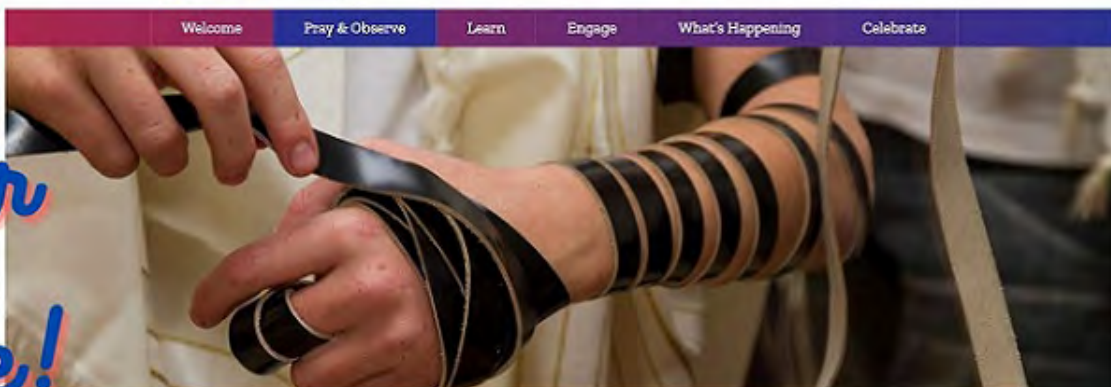

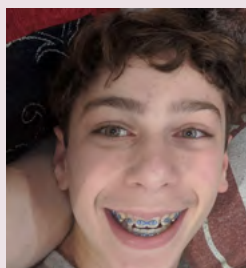

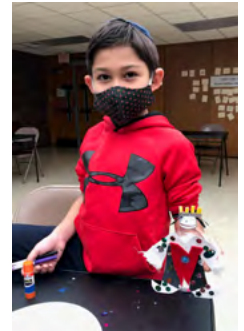

ADULT EDUCATION NEWS

During March and April, we concluded our series on the “Jewish Response to Persecution,” arranged by Alan Berkowitz, with a visit to the Museum of Jewish Resistance and prepared for Pesach with the help of a conversation between Rabbi Small and Rabbinic Intern Jessica Dell’Era. We also gained some insight into the possible impact of President Biden’s policies on Israel and the Middle East from Yoram Ettinger, retired Ambassador from Israel. Many of us learned more about the food and culture of Israel during a virtual Israeli food tour.

During the difficult past year of Covid-19 restrictions, some opportunities to expand our programming have arisen, thanks to the technology of Zoom. Gail Adler has represented the Emanuel Adult Education Committee in a consortium of synagogues throughout various parts of the country. Members of the consortium arrange presentations on a variety of topics of Jewish interest. Member synagogues have the opportunity to co-sponsor programs relevant to their communities and work together on arranging dates and times. We hope you can join us for some of these programs coming up in May and June.

The Natalie Ziplow study group has been meeting with Rabbi Small on Zoom, Thursdays at 10:30 a.m., with lively discussions of current events and text study.

- **Thursday, May 13, 7:30 p.m.:** **Virtual Tour of the Tenement Museum in New York City:** A Tenement Museum Educator will lead us through the home of the Rogarshevskys, a Jewish American family from Lithuania who moved to 97 Orchard Street during the 1910s.

- **Sunday, May 23, 8:00 p.m.:** Jonathan Lightman will take us on a **Magical Mystery Tour** of the Jews who interacted with the Beatles.

- **Thursday, May 27, 8:00 p.m.:** Rabbis, Rebels, and Supreme Court Justices: How Jewish Women Shaped Modern America with Professor Joyce Antler of Brandeis University.
