# Voting Information

*To participate in the MERCAZ voting process, please follow these steps:  
Please have a credit card ready to pay the \$5 fee.*

## 1. Access the Voting Website:

- a. Visit the voting portal at <https://azm.castiron.votem.net/election/037548cb-4cbb-4a94-aa9a-8aef017d4ddf>

## 2. Register to Vote:

- o Click on the "Register" button to create an account.
- o Provide the required personal information, such as your name, email address, and any other necessary details.

## 3. Receive Your PIN:

- o After completing registration, a Personal Identification Number (PIN) will be sent to your registered email address.
- o Check your inbox (and spam/junk folder, if necessary) for the message containing your PIN.

## 4. Log In to Vote:

- o Return to the voting website and log in using your registered email address and the provided PIN.

## 5. Cast Your Vote:

- o Once logged in, you'll see a list of options or candidates.
- o Locate MERCAZ, which is listed as Number 17.
- o Scroll down if necessary to find and select MERCAZ.

## 6. Submit Your Vote:

- o After making your selection, follow the on-screen instructions to review and confirm your vote.
- o Ensure you receive a confirmation that your vote has been successfully submitted.
