The refugee crisis is affecting many people coming for safety to our shores. Assistance is needed throughout our state. Historically, The Emanuel Synagogue has worked with the First Church of Christ in Farmington to support new families. The formed group, called GHRRC, (Greater Hartford Refugee Resettlement Coalition) has decided to try to help 3 families who recently arrived from Syria, presenting to the United States right before IRIS, (Integrated Refugee & Immigrant Service) a Connecticut resettlement group, had its monies taken away. Now these families are no longer supported. They are experiencing significant hardships trying to pay rent, find jobs, get household items, learn English, get health care and so much more. We are looking for help for these 3 families, 2 of whom have children.
