

## Celebrating Pentecost at St. Luke's

May 19 is Pentecost Sunday (also known as Whitsunday), which takes place on the 50th day after Easter Sunday to commemorate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Mary and the Apostles as they were in Jerusalem celebrating the Feast of Weeks.
