The purpose of the Career Expo is to showcase the career and college options that are available to local high school graduates. The Expo will take place on October 20, 2017, and thanks to The Chester County Economic Development (CCED) the Expo will again be held at the beautiful Gateway Conference Center in Richburg. Students from all three of the district's high schools will attend the event, and then tour the York Technical College Chester Campus. Approximately 350 Chester County seniors will be graduating June 2, 2018. These seniors will be looking for employment opportunities and/or seeking to further their education. The Career Expo is free & it is not a job fair. Rather, we need our business leaders in attendance to be positive role models for students, and help them build awareness and relationships within the surrounding business community.

We would like to invite you to attend this event. The theme for this year's Expo is **"What's in my own backyard?"** Not only will the students learn more about the many careers in their own backyards, but after the students depart there will be time for the businesses to network & find out what is in their own backyards.
