California's Confidential Mail Program

The Safe at Home Program is a statewide Confidential Address Program providing victims of domestic violence, stalking, sexual assault, human trafficking, and elder or dependent abuse as well as reproductive health care workers a way to prevent abusers from finding them at home, at work and at school. Program participants are assigned a substitute mailing address which is accepted by California state, county and city government agencies in lieu of a residential or other mailing address. Safe at Home offers victims anonymity as they rebuild their lives free from fear.
