

IMPORTANT: AP Updates for 2021 Exams

We're excited to announce this year's AP exams will offer the full-length testing experience. While students will access their exams online and test at home, the digital experience will not be a limitation. College Board has maintained their high standards, confirming students don't need to worry about the digital exam being easier or harder, as all versions of the exam will assess the same required course content and skills.

- Digital Format - ALL AP exams (with two exceptions) will be digital this year
 - Must use school-issued chromebook
 - Testing at home
 - Exams will be full-length--approximately 3.5 hours and are set on the dates listed below
 - Exams will begin at either 11:00 a.m. or 3:00 p.m. (see chart below), so please plan accordingly.
 - Tests marked with (*) on the chart, also offer a June digital testing date.
 - If you have **significant** concerns with digital at-home testing (inconsistent wifi, distracting environment, etc.), please contact Ms. Mieure (Jan.Mieure@cusd200.org) in the Counseling Center for other digital testing options.

- In-Person Format - Spanish & French only
 - College Board is not offering a digital version of these exams.

A refund (minus \$7 processing fee) will be initiated. If you cancel by March 25 at 2:30 p.m. you will receive a refund in April. For any exam cancelled after that date, or for any exam not attempted, the refund may not be processed until late June or early July.
