Objectives:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase utterance to 3-4 word phrases (I want more go, go outside, go up, help open, my turn, I want eat ____ .) • Label feelings • Label items (nouns, verbs – under CATEGORIES PAGE) • Greetings (in the activity row GREETINGS) • Expand on use of prepositions (Preposition bridge on main page) • Biographical information (ME activity row) • Use of Interjections (Fireworks on main page, yuk, awesome, yikes, oops) • Use of communication when expanding play skills (games) with an adult initially (my turn, you go, oh man, go fish, Do you have....) 		
Strategies:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When student is engaging in repetitive selections of buttons, state “We only say it once. Did you want to go out or play ____” Giving him a forced choice distracts from the repetition. • Student carries his talker himself throughout school. • If unsafe with the talker he should have access to a lite-tech (paper version) of his device. • Aided language stimulation: the more you can use the talker when communicating with the student even if it is just one word out of your full sentence it is modeling use for the student. • Verbal model recasting and expansion of phrases used on talker • Acknowledge and respond to talker use even if suspect it to be repetitive or unintentional
