Best Restaurants

Castaway Burbank 🌟 4.6 — A hilltop steakhouse with sweeping panoramic views of the San Fernando Valley. The surf & turf and fresh seafood are standouts, and the outdoor terrace at sunset is spectacular. Valet parking available. Open daily from 11am.

Granville 🌟 4.5 — A popular spot for elevated American comfort food using non-GMO oils and organic greens. Great for brunch (weekends from 10:30am) or lunch/dinner. Very family-friendly, with generous portions.

Palma Ristorante ★ 4.5 — Upscale Italian fine dining right in downtown Burbank. Known for exceptional branzino, grilled octopus, scallops, and Wagyu steaks. Free parking nearby. Open Tuesday–Sunday evenings.

Smoke House Restaurant 🌟 4.4 — A Hollywood institution since 1946, located directly across from Warner Bros. Famous for its cheese bread and prime rib, and has been featured in films and TV shows including *Argo*. A great piece of living history.

Finney's Crafthouse ★ 4.4 — Casual and fun, great for burgers, craft beer, and happy hour. A solid neighborhood spot with a lively patio. Open daily 11am–10pm.

In Glendale (~15 min away):

Backbone ★ 4.9 — A hidden gem with one of the highest ratings in the area. Chef Nate McCall delivers stunning dishes like NY strip with short rib burnt ends and unforgettable beet salad. Open Wednesday–Sunday evenings only.

Le Brand Restaurant ★ 4.8 — A stylish, upscale Glendale dining room with live music and a dance floor. Beautiful ambiance with olive trees and soft lighting — great for a special evening out. Closed Mondays.

In Hollywood (~20 min away):

Musso & Frank Grill ★ 4.6 — Hollywood's oldest restaurant, open since 1919. A classic old-school steakhouse with incredible steak tartare, Lobster Thermidor, and martinis that have been poured for legends. Reservations highly recommended. Closed Mondays.

Yamashiro Hollywood ★ 4.3 — A breathtaking Japanese-fusion restaurant perched on a Hollywood hillside with stunning views of the city. Best enjoyed at sunset. Open daily from 5pm (Sunday brunch from 11am).



Best Tourist Attractions

In Burbank:

Warner Bros. Studio Tour Hollywood ★ 4.4 — The most famous attraction in Burbank. Go behind the scenes at one of Hollywood's greatest studios. Includes the Friends set, Wizarding World exhibits, DC Comics props, costumes, and a working studio backlot. Book tickets in advance. Open daily 8:30am–3:30pm.

Batman: Hush Statue ★ 4.7 — A striking free bronze statue in Downtown Burbank's AMC walkway, inspired by Jim Lee's iconic artwork. A must-see for comic book fans and a great photo op. Open 24 hours.

Johnny Carson Park ★ 4.7 — A beautiful, well-maintained park named after the legendary Tonight Show host, located right next to NBC Studios. Great for a morning walk, picnic, or relaxing afternoon. Open daily 6am–8pm.

Gordon R. Howard Museum ★ 4.9 — A charming free local history museum covering Burbank's founding, aviation (a Lockheed airplane on display!), and silent film era. Open weekends only, 1–4pm.

In Hollywood (~20 min away):

Hollywood Walk of Fame ★ 4.0 — Over 2,700 stars embedded in the sidewalks of Hollywood Blvd and Vine Street. Free to visit 24 hours. Pair it with a visit to the TCL Chinese Theatre next door.

Hollywood Footprints (TCL Chinese Theatre) ★ 4.4 — Celebrity hand and footprints in cement dating back to 1927 with Douglas Fairbanks and Mary Pickford. Free to view outside; you can also tour the historic movie palace. Open 24 hours.

Madame Tussauds Hollywood ★ 4.5 — A world-class wax museum featuring incredibly lifelike figures of Hollywood legends, athletes, and more. Fun for families. Open daily 10am–8pm (Tues from 8am).

In Pasadena (~18 miles east):

The Gamble House ★ 4.8 — A stunning 1908 Arts & Crafts National Historic Landmark — and famously Doc Brown's house from *Back to the Future*. Guided tours available Tuesday, Thursday–Sunday, 10am–4pm. Book ahead!

Old Pasadena ★ 4.6 — A charming historic district along Colorado Blvd filled with boutique shops, restaurants, and cafes. Lovely for a stroll, especially on weekends. Free to explore anytime.
