- Promote development such as mixed-use retail, offices, and nearby live-work housing.
- Create a community commercial environment where car trips to purchase goods and services are within shorter distances.
- Encourage designs which promote environmental, forward-thinking concepts which enhance the unique characteristics of the community.
- \* NONE of these goals for the community are fulfilled by a regional car dealership located on one of the busiest corners in the county.
