## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 64" x 80"

WOF = Width of Fabric, LOF = Length of Fabric

This guide requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

The guide is intended to be used in conjunction with Lori Holt's Chicken Salad Sew Along. ## Cutting Diagram for Quilt & Block Border Fabrics **ONLY**

From each Fat Quarter used in the Quilt & Block Borders only,  
(The 21 fabrics used for these are shown here on pages 3 & 4)

Cut 1 – 8½" x 21" strip and sub-cut into 4- 4½" x 8½" rectangles  
to use in the Blocks and Border.  
(Some prints do not use all 4 rectangles)

Cut 2 – 4½" x 21" strips and sub-cut into 6- 4½" x 4½"  
squares to use in the Blocks and Border.  
(Some prints do not use all 6 squares)

\*Note: Henrietta needs an egg from 4 of these prints.

Block, Section and Border Layout for the Chicken Salad Quilt  
 Appliqué Chicken Blocks finish at 12" x 12" (unfinished 12½" x 12½").  
 After adding Border, Blocks finish at 16" x 16" (unfinished 16½" x 16½").  
 Quilt Border Blocks finish at 8" x 8" (unfinished 8½" x 8½").



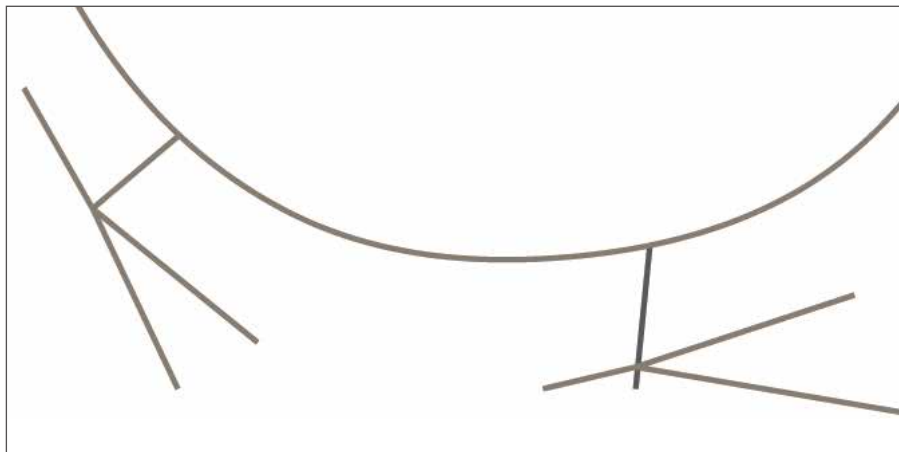
**Chicken Salad Quilt Size 64" x 80"**

10 Yards Large Alpine Vintage Trim Needed for Inside Binding & 2½ Yards Table Cloth Wide Back for Backing.

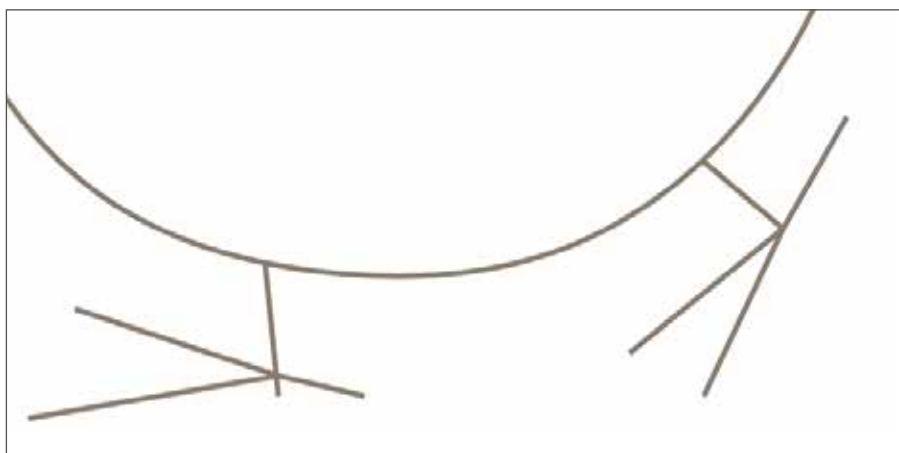

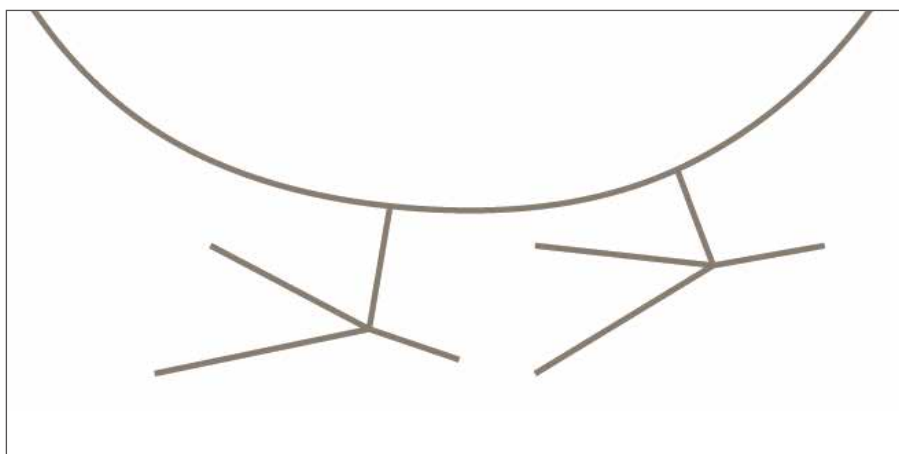
## Baby Chick Feet Embroidery Guide



Prudence and Florence Baby Chick Feet



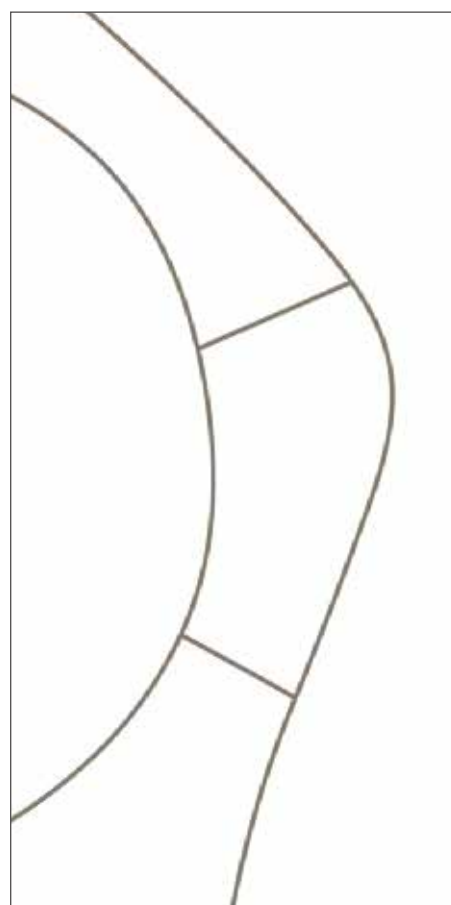

\*Tape these patterns onto Lori's Easy Trace™ Light Box using her Cook Book™ Washi Tape and trace lines directly onto fabric with a .05 mechanical pencil. Your embroidery will cover the pencil lines!
