We are excited to share an update about a special opportunity for our students! This year, we are launching a new program that combines Concordia's Growing Giving Hearts with last year's Benjamin Project.

Here's what you need to know:

- Students can apply to be a part of this generosity initiative.
- One student from each grade (K-12) will be selected to participate 13 students in total.
- Each student will receive seed money to bless someone or a group in our community. Amounts will vary by grade level, ranging from \$100 for early elementary up to \$400 for high schoolers.
- Students will lead their own projects planning, giving, and sharing how their gift made an impact.
- This program teaches students about generosity, service, and using their gifts to glorify God.
- At the end of the project, students will share their stories through photos, videos, or presentations.
