



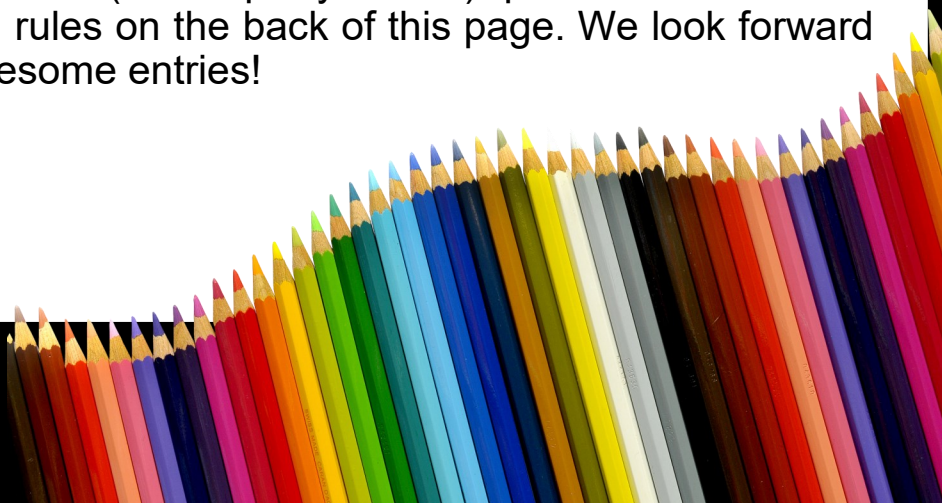
PARTICIPATE IN OUR ANNUAL “TUXEDO CARD” CONTEST FOR A CHANCE TO WIN \$50!

The winning teen will also be invited to our April meeting in honor of Alcohol Awareness Month and be given even more goodies!
