



FY22B - Pavement Maintenance (Overlay) Project

Beginning Monday, April 10, 2023, Lash Construction Inc. (Lash) will perform intersection improvement work on W. Valerio Street at Calle Canon and W. Valerio Street at Hillside Avenue. The work is part of the City of Santa Barbara's Fiscal Year 2022B (FY22B) Pavement Maintenance Project that includes the construction of new access ramps, a pedestrian crossing island, new concrete curb and gutter, the remaining link of the Modoc Multiuse Path, and pavement grind and overlay. The concrete improvements will enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety. The grind and overlay work consist primarily of grinding off deteriorated asphalt pavement and overlaying with new asphalt.

Please expect construction Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The concrete work is expected to last approximately three weeks at each location. After installation of the concrete improvements, a separate paving mobilization effort lasting approximately three to five days per intersection will take place to complete the grind and overlay operation.

Detours will be in effect to minimize construction duration and direct traffic. Traffic control and temporary delays should be expected in areas of construction. Access will be maintained for residents, although temporary disruptions should be anticipated. We greatly appreciate the public's cooperation and apologize for any inconvenience.

No parking signs will be posted at least 72 hours prior to construction and detour signs will also be provided.
