NIGHT WORK PLANNED! West Mission Street to Receive New Pavement

Toro Enterprises, Inc. (Toro) will be performing full-width paving of West Mission Street from Modoc Road to the Mission Creek Bridge as part of the FY21B Pavement Maintenance (Overlay) Project.

Paving work will take place at *night only* and is scheduled as follows:

- Tuesday, September 20: 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- Wednesday, September 21: 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

Pavement striping of the newly paved street will follow about four weeks after the paving is complete.

The schedule of work is approximate and is subject to change as weather, material supply and other factors may influence the exact timing of construction.

Detours in the surrounding areas will be in effect to minimize construction duration and ensure the least disruption to normal traffic flow. Traffic control, parking restrictions and temporary delays should be expected in these areas. Access will be maintained for local residents and businesses, although temporary disruptions should be anticipated, especially while paving is taking place.

No Parking signs will be posted at least 72 hours prior to construction and detour signs will also be provided.

The City has contracted with Toro to perform the work, which is funded primarily by Measure C.
