



Green Bike Lane Removal on State Street

Please expect significant traffic control, detours and delays at State Street intersections from Ortega Street to Victoria Street this Thursday, Oct. 20th and Friday, Oct. 21st.

American Asphalt South, Inc. has been contracted by the City of Santa Barbara to remove the temporary green bike lane pavement markings along this corridor. The work includes machine-grinding of the temporary markings at the intersections followed by the placement of a road slurry coat to seal and smooth out the rough, porous scar marks. The work will be performed one-half of each intersection at a time which will allow access from one direction at all times.

To minimize impacts to the public, the contractor will start each day at 6 a.m. and should be completed by 5 p.m.
