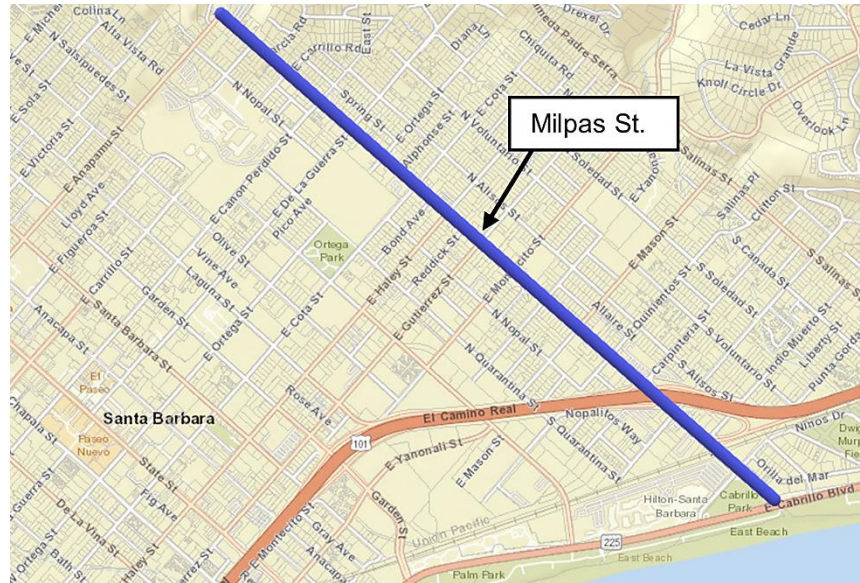




CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – Milpas Street Sidewalk Repair



The City of Santa Barbara Streets Operations Division is conducting repairs to uplifted and uneven sidewalks on Milpas Street between Anapamu Street and Cabrillo Boulevard starting Monday August 14th and will continue until early September.

This area will be open to traffic, but please expect disruption to traffic flow and construction noise Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this inconvenience.

This repair effort is in advance of and separate from the Milpas Street Crosswalk Safety and Sidewalk Widening Project (Long-Term Project), which is to improve pedestrian access throughout the Milpas Street corridor. The design for the Long-Term Project will commence in 2023, with construction anticipated in 2027.
