with you own hands in group of two or three volunteers with our guidance.

Wear comfortable work clothing and closed-toe shoes.

Bring water to drink, hat for sun, and work gloves if you have them.

Directions to Planting Site for January 26, 2019

Enter Centennial Park through its main entrance (from Edinger Ave) and park in the first parking lot on its left, close to the lake. From there, walk around the lake on the sidewalk on its left to the planting site on the opposite side of the lake.

On the map below, this path is shown blue, solid for driving and dashed for walking, and planting spots are circled red.
