An unusually intense storm pattern catches some commercial fishermen unaware and puts them in mortal danger. Starring George Clooney. 2 hours and 10 minutes. Rated PG-13.



July 29th @ 1:30 pm - Master and Commander: The Far Side of the World

Set during the Napoleonic Wars, a high-seas adventurer finds himself on the trail of a renegade French super-frigate. 2 hours and 18 minutes. Rated PG-13.

A band of Coast Guard troops steers out into impossible sea conditions in the dead of night to reach a crippled oil tanker. 1 hour and 57 minutes. Rated PG-13.
