We need eighty volunteers to make the day run smoothly! Volunteers are needed for the following roles:

- **Emcees** read the questions in each battle round and award points to the team that answers correctly.
- **Timekeepers** keep time for each battle round.
- **Scorekeepers** keep score for each battle round.
- **Room Monitors** ensure the number of people in a room does not exceed fire code limit, and will maintain a quiet and respectful atmosphere for the battle round to run smoothly.
- **Runners** bring the scores from the battle round hallway to the Scoremaster in the gym after each round.
- **Greeters** help run the registration desk, check in volunteers and teams, and help set up for the Final Battle.
- **Gym Monitors** help keep order in the gym between battle rounds.
- **Lunch Helpers** hand out pizza and water to teams during the break.
- **Photographers** take photos of the day, capturing memories!
