Welcome to your 2023 Hawver Kansas Legislative Guide

This is the year when party-line votes are going to tell the story on just what the Legislature/governor do/don't do to the rest of us in Kansas this year – a year when the state is hip-deep in spare cash.

Real issue this year: how much more taxpayer money the Legislature wants stored away in the state treasury with a now-projected ending balance of \$2.3 billion this fiscal year plus \$1 billion in the separate “Rainy Day” fund. Oh, and of course, whether taxpayers want that much money taken from their wallets/purses.

With Democrat Gov. Laura Kelly starting her

second – and last – term as captain of the ship, and Republicans holding on to their veto-override majorities in the House and Senate, this will be the session in which the GOP majority likely will determine whether gubernatorial vetoes will stand or fall. It takes 84 House votes to override a veto, and the Republicans' 85 members and Democrats' 40 members will make those votes attention-grabbers. Just two party-line crossing Republicans can sustain a veto.

The Senate? With 28 Republicans, 11 Democrats and Independent Sen. Dennis Pyle, the

Feb. 6 – Last day for non-exempt committees to request bill drafts.

Feb. 8 – Last day for introduction of bills by individual members.

Feb. 10 – Last day for non-exempt committees to introduce bills.

Feb. 21 – Last day for morning and afternoon committees to meet.

Feb. 22, 23 – On the floor all day.

Feb. 24 – Turnaround Day: Last day for consideration of bills by non-exempt committees in the house of origin.

Feb. 25-28 – No session.

March 24 – Last day for bills to be considered by non-exempt committees.

March 29 – Last day for non-exempt bills to be considered in either chamber.

March 30-April 2 – No session but conference committees may meet.

April 3-5 – Conference committees meet.

April 6 – Drop Dead Day for non-exempt bills, first adjournment.

April 7 – Spring break begins!

April 24-25 – Proforma days.

April 26 – Veto session opens.

April 29 – 90th Day, supposed last day of session.
