Sturgis Music Academy of the Arkansas Symphony Orchestra is offering violin group classes to Jefferson Elementary School as part of the Academy's outreach program. The program offers one class for violin beginners in 1st and 2nd grade, and one class for more advanced violin players in 3rd grade or above. The purpose of the program is to provide a comprehensive music education to the students through learning the violin.

The teacher for the program

Sturgis Music Academy director Tze-ying Wu received her Master of Music degree in viola performance from the Jacobs School of Music, Indiana University, and she is currently a candidate for Doctor of Music at the Jacobs School. Since 2012, she has been holding the position of violin/viola instructor at Indiana University's prestigious pre-college string program, Indiana University String Academy, where she worked closely with its director Professor Mimi Zweig, and its co director Dr. Brenda Brenner. The program has nurtured numerous professional string performers and educators, including world famous violinist Joshua Bell.
