



ISKIGAMIZIGAN (SUGARBUSH) EQUIPMENT LENDING PROGRAM

The Mino Bimaadiziiwin Tribal Farm and Red Cliff's Ginanda Gikendaasomin Library are collaborating on this year's Sugarbush Equipment Lending Program! The following sugarbush equipment is available for Red Cliff members to borrow on a first-come, first-served basis:

- Taps and buckets/bag kits
- Sap storage buckets/tanks
- Pans for boiling over a grate
- Thermometer & Canning jars

TO BORROW EQUIPMENT:

1) Check-out equipment from the Library

Starting Monday, March 20th, use your library card to check out equipment from the Ginanda Gikendaasomin Library located at 36750 Hwy 13.

2) Pick-up equipment from the Farm Office

Bring your library receipt to the Farm to pick up your equipment. Farm hours will be posted in library for each week. Equipment can also be delivered if needed.

3) Return your equipment to the Farm Office

Return equipment to the Farm by **May 15th**.

Farm staff will coordinate with the library to check the equipment back into the Library database.

The Tribal Historic Preservation Office has a grant to also offer support to Red Cliff members interested in tapping this season. THPO will be offering equipment for Red Cliff members to borrow and will also have an evaporator set-up at the THPO office for community members to use.
