RCCHA to Manage New Tribal Housing Stock

RCCHA will act as the leasing agent and property manager of all the new Housing stock being built. Each property has unique features and requirements. Tenant selection for units or to pursue homeowner sites within the development will flow through RCCHA. For rental unit applications, contact Mary Kay Defoe. Occupancy/Resident Services FAQs

Q: Is there a residency requirement to be added to the housing wait list?

A: No, but there is a point scale applied to applications based upon how long an applicant has resided in the RCCHA service area.

Q: What is RCCHA’s pet policy?

A: With prior approval, tenants are allowed 1-2 non-livestock, non-venomous pets that are licensed by the Tribe, with a paid pet deposit. Number of pets and deposit amount varies by project. *(Note: A determination has not been made yet as to whether pets will/will not be allowed in the new housing developments.)*

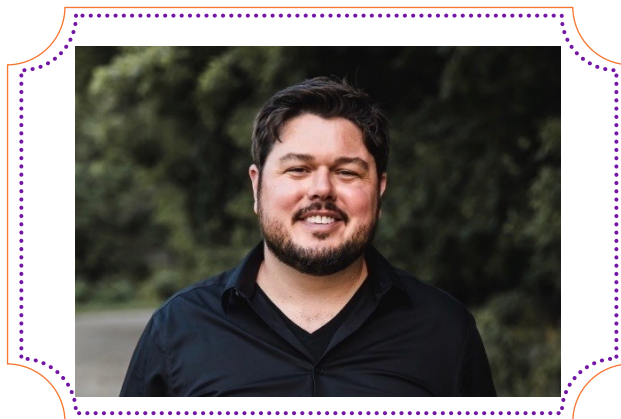
