

COVID-19 Situation Summary for Red Cliff, WI

April 6, 2020

Local Update

The number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Bayfield County stands steady at 3 as of April 6, 2020. Surrounding counties with confirmed cases are reported below:

- Ashland County (Ashland, WI) has 1 confirmed case.
- Douglas County (Superior, WI) has 7 confirmed cases.
- St. Louis County (Duluth, MN) has 16 confirmed cases.

Anyone with fevers and/or respiratory symptoms should call the clinic for phone triage. We ask that you do not present to the clinic in person without calling ahead of time. If it is after clinic hours, call MMC ER first. Many cases of COVID-19 can be treated at home with symptomatic management.

Global Update

COVID-19 infections globally surpassed 1,210,956 as of today with 67,594 total deaths. The United States has become the new epicenter of COVID-19 outbreaks. The Health Center continues to vigorously recommend:

Voluntary self-quarantine as the best way to keep yourself and your loved ones safe. Avoid receiving guests to the extent possible. If you go out, practice good social distancing. Wear some sort of protective cloth over your mouth and nose.

Frequent handwashing. Wash your hands throughout the day for at least 20 seconds each time.

COVID-19 Cases in Wisconsin

The total confirmed cases in Wisconsin is 2,440 of which 77 deaths.
