



Now Buying Apples

The Mino Bimaadiziiwin Tribal Farm is buying apples from Red Cliff members that we will use to make apple cider.

We will purchase apples for up to \$0.50/lb depending on the quality.

- Apples CANNOT be picked up from the ground, including if an apple is dropped during harvesting. Apples on the ground have a far greater chance of being contaminated with E-Coli and other pathogens that can cause serious illness.
- Apples CAN have cosmetic blemishes but should NOT have rotten spots.
- If you are not able to harvest your own apples but would like to donate your apples for community use, please contact us.
- Our first priority is to purchase from Red Cliff members, but depending on how many apples we receive we may consider purchasing from others as well. Please reach out with questions.

Now Buying Manoomin

The Mino Bimaadiziiwin Tribal Farm is buying wild harvest manoomin (wild rice) from Red Cliff harvesters to be shared during Red Cliff's youth camps.

We will purchase manoomin for up to \$30/lb depending on the quality.

- This is funded by a grant through the USDA Local Food Purchase Assistance (LFPA) program.
- **Prices are competitive as we value the knowledge and time needed to harvest and process these foods.**
