



The Red Cliff Pow Wow Committee is asking for the community's help in nominating two elders—one female and one male—to be honored at this year's 48th Annual Pow Wow.

This is a chance to recognize elders who have shared their time, wisdom, and care with the Red Cliff community (Gaa-Miskwabikaang).

Eligibility:

- Nominees must be **Red Cliff Tribal Members**.
- Nominees must be **55 years of age or older as of July 3, 2026**.

How to Nominate:

Complete the Nomination Form:

Fill out all sections of the Red Cliff Pow Wow Elder Honoree Nomination Form completely and accurately. An online form is available at www.redcliff-nsn.gov/powwow. Paper forms are also available at the Tribal Administration Building.

Provide Detailed Information:

In the "Nomination Details" section, share specific examples of the nominee's work, achievements, and contributions to the Red Cliff community. Please explain how the nominee has helped make Gaa-Miskwabikaang a better place. The more detail you provide, the better the Committee can review the nomination.

Supporting Materials (Optional):

You may include letters of support, photos, or other relevant materials. Indicate **"Yes"** in the appropriate section and list/describe them.

Submission:

Email the completed nomination form and any supporting materials to **RCPowWow@redcliff-nsn.gov**.

Deadline:

All nominations must be received by **April 1st, 2026**.

Late nominations will not be considered.

Selection Process:

The Pow Wow Committee will review all nominations received by the deadline. One female and one male elder will be selected to be honored. The selected honorees will be announced, featured on the Pow Wow flyer, and honored at the Pow Wow.
