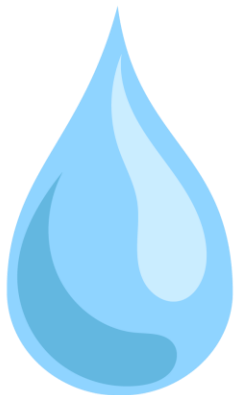

Keep a log of all the ways you used water for one day	Check all sinks and toilets in your home for leaks	Find another use for a plastic bag instead of throwing away	Use reusable or paper grocery bags instead of plastic	Turn off water when brushing your teeth
Take time to learn about a new local water source	Talk with your family and friends about ways to save water	Turn off water while washing your hands	Take less than a 5-minute shower	Make a list of five animals that may be affected by polluted water
Eat a meal that contains at least one local food source such as locally harvested fish, game and/or wild rice	Re-wear an outfit instead of washing after one use	"If it's yellow let it mellow, if its brown flush it down."	Dispose of pet waste properly	Wash produce in a bowl of water rather than under the faucet
