Mission Peak UU uses social media as a communications and publicity tool. We have MeetUp groups for Sunday Services and for the Sandwich Squad (which sometimes bring newcomers to our door), and we have a FaceBook Page and a private FaceBook Group. Some of you are regular FaceBook users, and some prefer to stay away for a variety of reasons, which I can understand. If you are a regular FB user you should know the difference between our Page and our Group. Our Page is for the public - it shares our programs, principals, and values with the world. If you "like" our page and follow it that helps get it wider viewership. We try to share our Sunday Services there (depending on the time our FB admin has that week), our special events that are open to the public, messages from the UUA, and we also re-share local events we think would be of interest to like-minded people (especially from the Tri-City Interfaith Coalition and the Youth Voter Movement). Some of us try to remember to "check in" on Sunday morning with a photo or comment about the service or other activity. Think of the Page as advertising. The Mission Peak UU Group, on the other hand, is a private group for members and friends of MPUUC only. Our administrators can only invite their friends to "join" the group, but that limits who gets to join. You can also look for the group and ask to join. I encourage you to do so. We share more internal information in the group, and can react and comment, unlike reading an article in the Week on the Peak!
