Course Descriptions

- **Lay Servant Basic Course** – The required course for all beginners to Lay Servant Ministries. Also serves as a refresher course for those who wish to be recertified.
 - **Leading Worship** – Focuses on the ministry of the lay servant who regularly or occasionally leads a group or congregation in worship.
 - **Soul Reset** – For anyone who moves at breakneck speed through their daily lives, often relying only on their own strength to bring God’s kingdom on earth.
 - **United Methodist Heritage** – Explore the special gifts of theology, witness and organization that The UMC brings to the church universal, how we got where we are today, and how our distinctive emphases are still needed in the 21st century church.
 - **Campus Ministry** – Understand and communicate the key role played by local churches in nourishing the spiritual lives of college students through campus ministries.
 - **Aging & Ministry in the 21st Century** – Older adult ministries need to be by and with elders, as well as for them, since participants will represent all stages of retirement and activity levels. (Zoom)
