In the event of an emergency, preparation, response and recovery are vital tasks of the church staff. Not only is the staff responsible for the buildings and property, but to the church members and surrounding community.

Basic Emergency Preparation and Supplies (given enough notice to act)

Have 3-5 days of drinking water, one gallon per day, per person 3-5 days non-perishable food supply per person Batteries for flashlights, etc First aid kit Current prescriptions Toolbox Cash Phone/computer **Baby supplies** Pet supplies Keep a bag packed for possible quick evacuation Know where important papers are and take them when you leave Secure or bring in outdoor furniture and trash cans Fill your car with gas Fill propane tanks Take photos and/or videos of the interior and exterior of your property Make prior arrangements with a family member, friend or neighbor to help you prepare in the event of an emergency-transportation, groceries, gas, etc. **If there is no one available to assist you in preparing, please call the church office for assistance.** 843-651-5099
