Getting Started

Step 1: Call Our Kinship Helpline: 1-888-561-2932
A Kinship Family Advocate will listen to your situation, answer your questions, and help determine next steps.

Step 2: Visit An Epworth Kinship Resource Center
Call or meet with a Family Advocate at an Epworth Kinship Resource Center. We'll help you:

- Apply for financial assistance (e.g., TANF, SNAP)
- Navigate legal guardianship processes
- Access items from our no-cost resource closet
- Notarize, copy, or scan documents
- Create a plan tailored to your family's needs
