The Work:

- We're looking for eager volunteers to help us receive, sort and label our plant sale plants.

- Learn about a number of our native plant species and how to identify them.

Why It's Helpful:

 Our Native Plant Sales are very popular fundraisers. We need to prepare and organize all the plants so they are ready for a busy pick-up day. Your volunteer work will help us ensure that our Native Plant Sale runs smoothly!

What To Expect:

- Be prepared to spend the day moving and labelling plants. Training on identification will be provided.
- There will be lots of bending and lifting 20-50 lbs.
- Work with a fun team to sort and label hundreds of plants by species.
- Must be able to read and write in English to ensure that all plants are correctly labeled.
- Wear weather-appropriate clothing and comfortable footwear.
- Please, bring your own snacks and a refillable water bottle (fresh drinking water is available).
