



Volunteer Activity: Plant Receiving and Placement

Are you someone who wants to make a difference for nature and the people of the Fraser Valley? Do you want to help wildlife living in urban environments and get your workout in at the same time? If so, we want you on our team!

The Work:

- This will involve unloading a truck full of plants which will range in size from 1 5 gallon pots, as well as bundles of cuttings.
- Estimated weight of each pot/bundle is 5-30 lbs.
- Plants will be carried around the park to the designated areas
- Plants will be placed with the direction of FVC staff

Why It's Helpful:

 Your efforts will be supporting planting that will provide services for wildlife, increase competition for damaging invasive species and add to the aesthetics of the park.

What To Expect:

- Rain or shine!
- Wear weather-appropriate clothing and sturdy footwear
- All training and gloves will be provided on the day of.
- Bring your own refillable water bottle! Fresh drinking water will be provided.
