His Work among Us: Model the Gospel

3. Is there anyone with whom you are not practicing or modeling the gospel? Ask God to work in you through His grace to live out the truth that the dividing wall of hostility which is broken down between all believers (Eph. 2:14).

✠ *Eph. 4:32 challenges us: “Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, **forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.**”*

4. Pray that we may be people full of the Holy Spirit, which would result in our worship and sense of community being energized and new people brought in.

✠ *Eph. 5:18: ...Be filled with the Spirit. ¹⁹**Speak to one another with psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord,** ²⁰always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. ²¹**Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.***

5. Pray that the marriages of Rainbow would be winsome and living portraits of the relationship that exist between Jesus and His bride, the church.

✠ Ephesians 5:25: “Husbands, love *your* wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her.”

✠ Ephesians 5:33: Wives, “see to it that *you* respect *your* husband.”
