Lesson Series: Tough Parables

Lesson 1: The Lost Sheep and Coin| Luke 15:1-10

Secondary Scriptures: Psalm 139:13-17

We started a new series on parables this week. Over the next few weeks, we'll explore and wrestle with some of Jesus' challenging parables. He often taught by using parables—intentional stories that related an eternal truth to everyday life.

In this first lesson, we explored Luke 15:1-10, where Jesus shares the parable of the lost sheep and the parable of the lost coin. We discussed how Jesus, as the Shepherd, leaves the 99 sheep to pursue and save the one lost sheep—and then how he values us even more than the coin that the woman turned her house upside down to find.

These stories help us see how important we are to Jesus and how he pursues each of us individually.

In the next week, creatively find some time to talk with your teenager about these truths.

Feel free to start with these questions:

- When have you lost something important?
- If you found that lost item, how did you feel when you found it?
- How do you feel about Jesus pursuing you?
