GOAL To prepare committed and qualified individuals to assume leadership roles in Brunswick County.

OBJECTIVES Identify and cultivate highly motivated potential community leaders.

Systematically educate and challenge the participants about the needs of the community as well as the dynamics of social and economic change.

Develop an esprit de corps among participants which will provide a common ground for working together on present and future community needs.

Create a dialogue and sense of teamwork between the participants and existing community leadership.

Identify organizational and individual opportunities for community involvement and assist in the placement of the participants.

Guidelines and Information

- **Attendance and Class Days:** Class days are held every third Wednesday of the month between the months of October-May (dates subject to change)
- Participants must attend 6 sessions to graduate. Attendance at orientation is **mandatory**. In addition, participants will be required to take part in enrichment activities, attend a municipal or county public meeting and volunteer 10 hours at a designated non-profit.
- **Selection Criteria and Application Review:** Applications will be evaluated and considered for admission. The selection criteria are civic involvement, leadership potential, diversity of perspective and commitment to the leadership program and the community. The class size is limited to a minimum of 10 and up to 30 members.
- **Tuition:** Tuition in the Leadership Brunswick County program is \$450 for Chamber members and \$500 for non-Chamber members. Full payment must be made by September 18, 2024. Checks payable to Leadership Brunswick County. Tuition is non-refundable. Drop off at any of the three Chambers or mail to 4433 Long Beach Road, Southport, NC 28461.
