

Sundara Kaanda is the fifth book in the [Hindu](#) epic, the [Ramayana](#). The original *Sundara Kanda* is in [Sanskrit](#) and was composed by [Valmiki](#), who was the first to scripturally record the *Ramayana*. Sundara Kanda is the only chapter of the *Ramayana* in which the hero is not [Rama](#), but rather [Hanuman](#). The work depicts the adventures of [Hanuman](#) and his selflessness, strength, and devotion to Rama are emphasized in the text. Hanuman was fondly called "Sundara" by his mother Anjani and Sage Valmiki chose this name over others as the Sundara Kanda is about Hanuman's journey to Lanka. After learning about Sita, Hanuman assumes a gargantuan form and makes a colossal leap across the ocean to Lanka after defeating [Surasa](#), the Mother of the Nagas and Sinhika, who is sent by the [Devtas](#). In Lanka, Hanuman searched Sita and finally found her in [Ashok Vatika](#).
